
# SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

special focus on elderly individuals, homeless persons, and daily wage workers.





The MP School Construction Project in Madhya Pradesh is a ₹3 Crore infrastructure initiative aimed at establishing a permanent educational institution for underserved communities. With land secured and phased construction underway, the school is designed to accommodate 500+ students in a structured, safe, and scalable learning environment.

Once completed, it will serve as a long-term educational asset, expanding access to quality education for future generations.

# SCHOLARSHIPS

*Investing in Education Today to Create Leaders of Tomorrow.*

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The Scholarship Program supported 47+ students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds by providing direct tuition fee assistance for the full academic year. Covering both school and college-level education, the initiative ensured uninterrupted learning and achieved a 100% retention rate among sponsored students. Through a structured need-based selection

process and ongoing academic monitoring, the program removed financial barriers and enabled students to continue their educational journey with stability and confidence.



All scholarship fees are transferred directly to the respective educational institutions through bank transactions. This direct-payment model ensures complete financial transparency, proper documentation, and full audit compliance while guaranteeing that funds are used solely for academic purposes.

community engagement, and structured learning programs. The project is currently in the fundraising phase to enable construction commencement.





The Minhaj Learning & Research Centre (MLRC) is an educational initiative dedicated to providing structured Qur’anic and foundational Islamic education for children while nurturing strong moral and character development. Operating as a learning hub for young students, the centre delivers regular classroom-based

instruction in a safe and disciplined environment. To sustain its educational activities, faculty support, and operational needs, the centre requires approximately **₹20 lakhs in annual expenses**, ensuring that quality faith-based education remains accessible to the community.
